

Length of EE draft

7-8	Draft has reached or exceeded 2,500 words. (no clear evidence of fluff and fill simply to meet word count)
5-6	Draft has reached or exceeded 2,000 words. (no clear evidence of fluff and fill simply to meet word count)
3-4	Draft has reached or exceeded 1,500 words. (no clear evidence of fluff and fill simply to meet word count)
1-2	Draft has been started but has not reached the 750 word mark.
0	Student fails to reach a descriptor above "0"

Research Question and Focus of Draft

9-10	The RQ is clearly stated and focused and appropriately connected to the discussion
7-8	The RQ is stated and partially focused, and partially connected to the discussion
4-6	The RQ is stated but vague or too broad for effective treatment and is disconnected from the discussion
1-3	There is no clear RQ and the draft is incoherent and/or unfocused.

Works cited

7-9	Draft includes citations throughout, a works cited page, and an appropriate selection of relevant sources
4-6	Draft includes moderate use of citations, a works cited page, and some use of relevant sources
1-3	Draft includes few citations, an incomplete works cited page, and a limited number of relevant sources

Subject content

7-9	Knowledge of the topic is clear, subject terminology is used appropriately and sources are used effectively
4-6	Knowledge of the topic is reasonably clear, subject terminology is used mostly appropriately and sources are used somewhat effectively
1-3	Knowledge of the topic is limited, subject terminology is inconsistent, and sources are not used effectively

8-10	Excellent quality for a 1st draft
5-7	Good quality for a 1st draft
3-4	Mediocre quality for a 1st draft
1-2	Poor quality for a 1st draft
